Effective July 1, 2020, the following changes will be made to your Deposit Account Agreement and Truth-in Savings Disclosure.

Funds Availability Policy: Longer Delays May Apply & Special Rules for New Accounts

Longer Delays May Apply

The first \$225 of your deposits will be available on the first (1st) business day after the day of deposit.

Special Rules for New Accounts

Funds from electronic direct deposits to your account will be available on the day we receive the deposit. Funds from deposits of cash, wire transfers, and the first \$5,525.00 of a day's total deposits of cashier's, certified, traveler's, and federal, state and local government checks will be available on the first (1st) business day after the day of your deposit if the deposit meets certain conditions. For example, the checks must be payable to you. The excess over \$5,525.00 will be available on the ninth (9th) business day after the day of your deposit. If your deposit of these checks (other than a U.S. Treasury check) is not made in person to one of our employees, the first \$5,525.00 will not be available until the second (2nd) business day after the day of your deposit.
